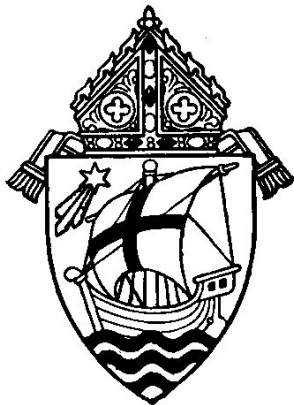

Right Relationships provides children and young people with a foundation for understanding that human relationships are based on God's unconditional love for us and His desire for each of us to love one another.

Because human beings are formed in God's image, we should treat everyone with respect.

Right relationships are built on trust. Telling the truth, even when we are afraid of the consequences, is one way we show respect for each other and build right relationships. Relationships that are not built on trust are not "right" relationships.

Children and young people who are in relationships that are not "right" may need to tell a trusted adult to help them get out of the relationship.

**If you believe a child has been
subjected to abuse and at the time

A) the victim is under age 18, Utah law requires that you contact the Division of Child and Family Services (DCFS).
