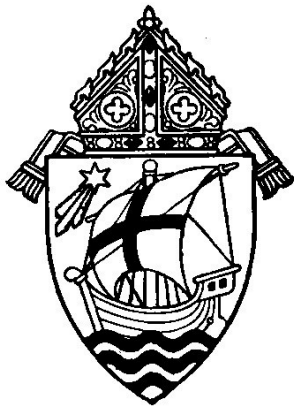

**If you believe a child has been  
subjected to abuse and at the time  
the abuse is reported:**

**A) the victim is under age 18**, Utah law requires that you contact the Division of Child and Family Services (DCFS).

**In Utah,**

In addition, if the alleged abuser is an employee or volunteer of the diocese or the abuse occurs on diocesan property, call the Diocesan Pastoral Center at (801) 328-8641.

**B) the victim is 18 or older** and the alleged abuser is an employee or volunteer of the diocese, or the abuse occurs on diocesan property, call the Diocesan Pastoral Center at (801) 328-8641.
